FUN FACTS


- » In the Roman calendar, August was known as "Sextilis", the Latin word for 6. It wasn't until 700 BC when January and February were added to the calendar, that August was bumped down to become the 8th month of the year.
- » Come on, August! Make a choice! The number of days in August has changed many times. First it was 30 days. Then, 31. When January and February came onto the scene, August got reduced to 29 days. Then, Julius Caesar changed it back to 31. Thankfully it has remained that way ever since.
- » While "Sextilis" does have a somewhat naughty ring to it, it was in 8 BC when it was dropped and Augustus became the official name. The month was named in honor of Augustus Caesar, the Roman emperor and adopted son of Julius Caesar. Eventually, Augustus was shortened to simply, August.




EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH
